Rev 6 The Seven Seals

Rev 6:1 Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the <u>seven seals</u>, and I heard one of the four living creatures saying as with a voice of <u>THUNDER</u>, "COMES"



Seven seals
Opening each seal reveals the providence of God

in the lives of men.

Compare Isa 10:5-7

v.2 I looked, and behold, a white horse



White: Bible symbol of purity. White Robes 3:4; 4:4; 6:2... White Horse of Christ who wages war Rev 19:11

Horse: in the OT is the symbol for War. Prov 21:31 Horse for the day of battle

Jer 8:6 like horse charging into battle

Zech 10:3 like His majestic horse in battle

Rev 6:2 He who sat on it had a bow & crown

Christ = rider on a white horse ! Rev_19:11-16

Barnes; Hailey; McQuiggan; Hendricksen.

Others think it represents conquest by:
Roman empire; the Parthians; Satan;
A False Christ; the Holy Spirit, Angel;
The coming world dictator Anti-Christ.

Rev 6:2 He who sat on it had a bow...

Bow: "A great bow (toxon) drawn by placing one foot upon it." Vincent.

The bow was viewed as a weapon of God in the OT


Ps 7:2 He has bent His bow.

Lam 3:12 He has bent His bow,

...made me a target for His arrows.

Hab 3:9 Your bow was made bare...

Rev 6:2 He who sat on it had a bow & crown



Rev 6:2 He went forth **Conquering...**

Conquering: Jesus is seen here as the conquering enemy of Rome. McQuiggan

Crassus (Roman Procounsul of Syria) attacked Parthian empire in 53 BC against advice on how to proceed.

Parthia had mounted archers in full armor & a camel train of extra arrows. Rome lost with 20,000 killed & 10,000 captured." Plutarch "Lives"

Rev 6:3 - 4 Second Seal: War!

Rev 6:3 When He broke the <u>second seal</u>, I heard the second living creature saying, "Come." v.4 Another, <u>a Red Horse</u> went out

Red horse: The Color of Blood

Rev 6:4b "To him it was granted to take peace from the earth that men should <u>slay one another</u>"

Slay: Sphazo (4969) To butcher, especially an animal for food or in sacrifice; or generally to slaughter or to maim violently. Strongs

Rev 6:3 - 4 Second Seal: War!

Rev 6:4 To him who sat on it, it was granted to take peace from the earth, and that men would slay one another and a Great Sword was given to him.

Great (mega-lee): Large, long.

Sword (machaira). A <u>long</u> sword in battle. Robertson





Rev 6:5-6 Third Seal: Famine!

Rev 6:5-6 When He broke the third seal, I heard the third living creature saying, "Come." I looked, & behold, a black horse and he who sat on it had a pair of scales

Black Horse – famine, economic hardship. *McQuiggan p.99*

Quart of wheat for a denarius: day's wage buys enough for 1 person for 1 day. Robertson; Vines

Three Quarts of barley for a denarius: Work a full day for cheaper food, but it'll feed 3 for a day.

Rev 6:5-6 Third Seal: Famine!

Rev 6:6 And I heard something like a voice in the center of the four living creatures saying... do not <u>damage</u> the <u>oil</u> & <u>wine</u>...



"On such a meager salary one could provide only a bare living & would find it impossible to afford any of these luxuries." Hailey p.192

"A Christian who refused to compromise by sustaining membership in a pagan guild would be hard-pressed to ..earn a living." IBID

Rev 6:7-8 Forth Sealt Death!

Rev 6:7 When the Lamb broke the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature saying, "Come." v.8 I looked, & an ashen horse and he who sat on it had the name Death .. Hades following Ashen: Greenish - yellow. Homer used this word (chlooros) of the ashen color of a face blanched by fear." Robertson 🍴 🗊 Hades (unseen realm of dead Lk 16) following **Death**, as always (Rev 1:18; 20:13-14)

Rev 6:7-8 Forth Seal: Death I

Rev 6:8 Authority was given to them over a *fourth* of the earth, to kill with *sword* and with *famine*, *pestilence* and by the *wild* beasts of the earth.

Cf (Ezek 14:21) I send My four severe judgments... sword, famine, wild beasts & plague

4 judgments in Ezek 14:21 are on Jerusalem

The 4 judgments in Rev 6:8 are on 1/4 Earth

Rev 6:9-11 Fifth Seal: Martyrs !



Rev 6:9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been slain because of the word of God & testimony they maintained..

The Souls: Martyrs in persecution, slain because of God's Word. OT sacrificial blood was poured at base of the altar. (Lev 4:30) The Life is in the blood and was sacrificed to God. (Lev 17:11)

Rev 6:9-11 Fifth Sealt Ma



Rev 6:10 They cried out with a loud voice, saying, "How long, O Lord, holy and true, will You refrain from judging and avenging our blood on those who dwell on the earth?"

Avenging — (Ek-dikeis). Vengeance is not unscriptural when left in the hand of God. (Deut 32:35; Rom 12:19)

Vengeance: that which proceeds from justice.

Cry for vindication! Right the wrong!

Abel (Gen 4:10); Habakkuk's plea! (Hab 1:1)

Rev 6:9-11 Fifth Sealt Martyrs !

Rev 6:11 There was given to each of them a white robe and they were told that they should rest for <u>a little while longer</u>, until the number of their fellow servants & their brethren who were to be killed ... would be completed also.

white robe: emblem of purity; victory over sin (Rev 3:4-5, 18)

Emperor Domitian 81-96 He ordered persecution AD91 & was murdered in AD96 Foxe

Rev 6:9-11 Fifth Seal: Martyrs!

Rev 6:11b They should rest for <u>a little while</u> <u>longer</u> ... [How long is a little while?]

Mat 11:14 Elijah was to come (Grk: mello = about).

But (Mal 4:5) was fulfilled 375 years later.

Rom 5:14 Adam was a type of Christ who "was to come." (Greek word 'mello' = "about")

spanned several millennia.

Heb 10:1 Law of Moses was a shadow of good things (about 'mello') to come.

But time spanned 1600 years.

Rev 6:12 I looked when He broke the sixth seal and there was a great earthquake...



Fall of Babylon: described as the earth shaken out of its place. (Isa 13:1,13)

Fall of Jerusalem 586BC Mtns quake (Jer 4:24)

An <u>earthquake</u> symbolizes great agitations, overturnings & massive changes.

Rev 6:12 And the Sun became black as sackcloth made of hair, and the whole moon became like blood [National Calamity]

Fall of Babylon: The sun will be DARK (Isa 13:1,10) when it rises... Fall of Egypt: When I extinguish you.. I will cover the sun with a cloud. (Ezek 32:2,7-8) The Fall of Jerusalem: AD 70 "And the Sun will turned into darkness & moon into blood " (Joel 2:31; Mat 24:29)

Rev 6:13 The stars of the sky fell to the earth

Stars are a million times bigger than our earth. If they <u>literally</u> fell to earth then all life & the earth itself would be vaporized.

Hal Lindsey says this represents a **Russian** nuclear missile attack.

Gen 37:9-11 Joseph's family was represented by sun, moon and stars. This is also used for **mighty men** Dan 8:10,24.

Rev 6:14 The <u>sky was split apart like a scroll</u> when it is rolled up and <u>every Mountain & Island were moved</u> out of their places.

"The sense is, that there would be great destruction among those high in office." Barnes

For Edom Isa 34:4 "All the host of heaven will wear away & sky will be rolled up like a scroll.

Earth has a literal 2 million islands. answers.com. There are a 100 mountain RANGES on earth. Just shows massive, social upheaval. (Lk 3:5)

Rev 6:15 Then the *kings* of the earth & the *great* men ... *commanders* ... *rich* ... *strong* & every *slave* & *free* man hid themselves in the caves ...

Israelites hid themselves in times of danger.

Judges 6:2 Israel hid from *Midianites*

- 1 Sam 13:6 Israel hid *Philistines*
- 1 Sam 24:1-3 David hid from Saul
- 1 Ki 19:9-10 Elijah hid from Jezebel

Rev 6:16 They said to the mountains and to the rocks, "Fall on us & hide us"

There is a desire to be *hidden* by falling rocks and hills rather than face God's vengeance. cf UBS Edom used the same language (Hos 10:8) Then they will say to the mountains, "Cover us!" And to the hills, "Fall on us!"

Rev 6:17 "For <u>the great day of their wrath</u> <u>has come</u>, and who is able to stand?"

Great Diversity of Opinion

2. Persecution under *Diocletian* AD 300

3. The Fall of Rome AD 476
