#### A. Salutation: Church Character v. 12

Rev 2:12 to the angel of the church in



Colonists struck the <u>first coins</u> here in 420BC.

**Pergamum** write:

**City** in wide valley 15 mi. from Aegean

Most <u>beautiful city</u> in east: with Temples, Theater, Library with 200K vol 2<sup>nd</sup> only to Alexandria, Egypt

#### B. Jesus' Self-Designation 2:12


Rev 2:12 One who has the sharp two-edged sword

- a. Sword: In (Rev 1:6) from His Mouth
- b. <u>Symbol</u>: In (Eph 6:16) = Word of God.
- c. <u>Use</u>: (Rev 19:15) <u>Word</u> is a weapon "with it He <u>might smite the nations</u>."
  - "God's <u>Sword</u> is described as <u>His instru-</u> ment of judgment (Isa 34:5; Jer 12:12;
    - 47:6; Isa 66:15-16)." Inter Varsity Press

Rev 2:13 | know where you dwell, where Satan's throne is!



THREE temples to the Caesars.

TWO temples for Greek religions

- To **Zeus**—mercy & justice.
- To Athena—wisdom, war.

**TWO** temples for **Asiatic Religions**To **Dionysus**- farms, wine & orgies.
To **Asclepius**—healing & medicine.

## Mapter 2:12-17 Letter to Pergamuli, C. Commendation 2:13

Rev 2:13 <u>Did not deny My faith</u> even in the days of <u>Antipas</u>, My witness, My faithful one who was killed among you <u>where Satan dwells</u>.

McClintock & Strong Encyclopedia: ANTIPAS, "A martyr, said to have been a bishop of Pergamum, and put to death in a tumult there by the priests of Aesculapius, (<u>Eusebius</u>, Hist. Eccl. 4, 5). Tradition relates that he was burned in a brazen bull under <u>Domitian</u>."

# Mapter 2:12-17 Letter to Pergamus. D. Complaint 2:14-15

#### Rev 2:14-15 But I have a <u>few things</u> <u>against you</u>

# 1 <u>Some held the teaching of Balaam</u>— <u>sexual sin</u> & <u>idolatry</u> is accepted. Fatal compromise in religion (Num 31:15-16).

# 2 Some who hold the teaching of the Nicolaitans
"Professing Christians, introduce a false freedom"
(Fausset's). "Mingling themselves in the orgies of
idolatrous feasts, they brought the impurities
of those feasts into the meetings of the
Christian Church." (from Smith's

## Mapter 2:12-17 Letter to Pergamuni

#### E. Warning 2:16

Rev 2:16 'Therefore repent or else I am coming to you quickly, and I will make war against them with the sword of My mouth.

His word has **POWER** to calm the sea, created worlds, & raised dead.

As a result neither Nicolatians, Balaamites left documents nor institutions behind.



## Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to The A. Salutation v. 18

### Rev 2:18 To the angel of the <u>church</u> <u>in Thyatira</u>

It was a <u>wealthy</u> commercial town in the Lycus valley. It has a population of 100,000.

The gospel may have reached here as a result of <u>Paul's</u> conversion of Lydia (Acts 16:15) or his <u>teaching</u> in Ephesus (Acts 19:10).





## Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to Tomber A. Salutation 2:18a

Thyatira was noted for its trade guilds. Every artisan belonged to a guild, & every guild, owned property, wielded a wide influence. Lydia sold her purple fabrics in places like Philippi, and was a native of Thyatira.

# Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to The B. Jesus Self-Designation 2:18b

Rev 2:18 The Son of God, who has eyes like a <u>flame of fire</u> and his feet are like <u>burnished</u> bronze <u>Eyes Searching-Penetrating</u>

Heb 4:13 Is <u>no creature hidden from</u>
<u>His sight</u>.. all things are open & laid bare to the eyes of Him...

2 Chron 16:9 The eyes of the Lord move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His.

# C. Commendation v. 19

Rev 2:19 I know your deeds, and your <u>love</u> and <u>faith</u> & <u>service</u> and <u>perseverance</u>, and that your <u>deeds of late are greater</u> than at first.

Thyatira toiled & persevered like <u>Ephesus</u> but also maintained it's Love (2:5)

And was better than <u>Sardis</u> who didn't complete deeds (3:2)



### Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to Thyating

Rev 2:20 D. Complaint v. 20-21

But I have this against you, that you tolerate the woman Jezebel

Probably the name is used metaphorically for Extremely wicked woman of the Bible.

Who calls herself a <u>prophetess</u>, and she teaches and leads My bond-servants astray so that they commit acts of immorality and eat things sacrificed to idols.



# Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to Thyming D. Complaint v. 20-21 continued

Rev 2:21 I gave her <u>time</u> to repent, & she does <u>not want to</u> repent of her immorality.

Church Discipline is **Critical** (1 Cor 5: 1-13)

God shows More or Less <u>Patience</u> Depending (2 Peter 3:9) God is patient toward you not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance.

Show Love. Anticipate the progress. Set time to CHANGE. What is needed: 2 days? 14 days? More/Less? But some people just don't want to change!

Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to The Rev 2:22-23 v. 22-23

Warning

Behold, I will:

- 1. Throw her on a bed of sickness She'll suffer.
- 2. Those Commit adultery with her into great tribulation, (Huge problems for ungodly acion.)
- 3. I will kill her children with pestilence, (death)
- 4. All the churches will know (Secret sin punished)
- 5. I will give to each one of you according to your deeds. (Gal 6:7) Reap-Sow

### Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to Thyming F. Exhortation v. 25


Rev 2:25 Nevertheless what you have, hold

fast until I come.

What you have: they had several good points: toil, perseverance, love, faith & service. (v.19)

**Hold Fast:** Hang on tight (Imperative Greek Mode)

**Till I come:** coming in Earthly judgment (v 22-23).

### Mapter 2:18-29 Letter to Thyatira


G. Promise v. 26-29 continued

Rev 2:29 And I will give him the morning star.

"Morning star"— is Venus: high in the eastern sky just before sunrise.

Rev 22:16 [ <u>Jesus</u> ] The bright morning star. Nu 24:17 [ <u>Jesus</u> ] Star shall rise from Jacob.

[Jesus] promises to give *Himself* to overcomers. He brings light, life, and joy. *Pulpit*
