The Church Selected

men to serve the church.

(Acts 6:3) "The twelve summoned the congergation of the disciples and said... <u>select</u> from among you seven men." (Not the apostles)

<u>Church also chose</u> men to serve as messengers.

(1Cor 16:3) "Whomever <u>You Approve</u> I will send with letters to carry your gift to Jerusalem."

Step #3 Church Evaluates the Men

<u>Qualified</u>— Confident in that specific quality.

Unqualified — Provable sin in an area.

<u>Other</u>— Explain: Unknown. I'm too new. Concern. If just your opinion—forget it.

If man is approved, he's appointed !

Willing to give Themselves, Time & Money. Does your family agree ?

Our Congregation's Attitude

- **1. Righteous Judgment**: (John 7:24; Mat 7:1-2) Consider current issues, not corrected past.
- 2. Honesty and Courage (2Tim 1:7) Not timidity Absence of signature at bottom-- invalidates list.
- 3. Consider Degree of Qualifications Not Superlative ie. "Best imaginable" Not Comparative "Better than the other pur" Some are Absolute- "Husband of one wife" Some are Relative- "Good manager"

Candidates if Not Selected

A. Joseph Justus Barsabbas: (Acts 1:23-26)

As mature Christian, he'd keep on serving even if not as apostle. Rom 8:28

B. Jonathan—Son of Saul: (1Sam 18:1; 20:4-5, 30-33, 41-42) Always trying to do what's Best ! Willing to serve in whatever capacity! Never a hint of jealousy or competition!


We Will <u>All</u> Be Examined

Men You Think <u>MAY</u> be Qualified as Deacons 2016

- 1. <u>Dignified</u>: Respected for his character. Has a good reputation.
- 2. Not double-tongued: Honest, truthful, reliable
- 3. <u>Not Addicted to much wine</u>: Not an addict. Puts the church above own selfish desires (1 Cor 10:32-33)
- <u>Not fond of sordid gain</u>: Ethical. Not fond of money gained dishonestly.
- 5. <u>Holding the mystery of the faith in a clear conscience</u>: A Christian who has right motives for wanting to serve. They are stable and studied.
- 6. <u>First be tested</u>: Known for being consistent, hard-working & moral.
- 7. <u>Beyond reproach</u>: un-impeachable. No charge of current sin can be sustained.
- 8. *Women likewise*: (ie. Wives of deacons)
 - a. *Dignified*—honorable, held in esteem.
 - b. **Not malicious gossips**—not given to fault finding and spreading innuendos in the church.
 - c. *Temperate*: self-controlled, balanced in life.
 - d. *Faithful in all things*—Trusted, reliable in all things.
- 9. *Husband of one wife*: Having not more nor less than one wife.
- 10. <u>Good manager of his children & household</u>: Is he a good manager of both people (his children) and things

(possossions)
