
II. Winds of Apostasy Already Blowing A. Jewish False Teachers (Col 2:16; Titus 1:10, 14) B. Lure of Idolatry & Immorality (Rev 2:20) C. Resistance to Apostolic Authority (3 John 9 -10) D. Gnostic Poison: (1 John 2:18f) Many Antichrists (2 John 7) "Many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the *deceiver* and the Antichrist. (Col 2:8) "See to it that no one takes you according to the tradition of men... rather than according to Christ. v9 For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form."

III. NT Church Always had Multiple Elders

Acts 15:2, 4, 6, 22, 23; 16:4 Jerusalem *elders* Acts 20:17, 28 *Elders* from the church at Ephesus Phil 1:1 *Elders* at Philippi with deacons & saints 1 Thes 5:12 [Thessalonica] *have charge over* you.

Acts 14:23 They appointed *elders* in every church Titus 1:5 Appoint *elders in every* city James 5:14 Call for the *Elders* of the church 1 Pet 5:1-2 *Elders* shepherd flock... among you Heb 13:7, 17 Obey *those* who *Watch over* you.

IV. The *Drift* from NT Multiple Elders



"The *apostolic writings* indicate that... the general organization was for local churches to be presided over by a plurality of elders" also called bishops, assisted by deacons. Early Christians Speak, p.13

Everett Ferguson ACU Masters **Harvard Phd**

"The writings of Ignatius of Antioch to the churches of Asia Minor in **Early 2nd century** describe a threefold ministry of one bishop, a plurality of elders and deacons in the churches." IBID.

V. Change in *Biblical Church Organization*




Ignatius of Antioch began to speak of a <u>Bishop</u> & <u>Elder</u> as <u>separate</u> offices AD 105.

"Let all reverence the deacons as an appointment of Jesus Christ, and the bishop as Jesus Christ... and the presbyters as the Sanhedrin of God, & assembly of the apostles. Apart from these, there is no Church." (Epistle to Trallians 3 & 13)

"All of you follow the <u>bishop</u> as Jesus Christ does the Father & the <u>presbytery</u> [elders] as apostles. It is not lawful without the <u>bishop</u> ... to baptize." (Epistle to Smyrnaens 8)

But the Bible uses these terms Interchangeably ! Elders (Acts 20:17) = Bishops/Overseers (Acts 20:28)

V. Change in *Biblical Church Organization*



Ignatius of Antioch in Syria *c AD 35- 108* "There is <u>one bishop</u>, along with the presbyters & deacons." Ignatius ANF 1.81


Why did Ignatius promote bishops? To deal with rising heresy & heretics.

"The followers of false teaching were holding their own schismatic assemblies. Ignatius' program to deal with the false teachers and their divisive influence was to <u>center all the congregational activities</u> <u>under one head, the bishop</u>." <u>Early Christians Speak</u>, p.94

Ignatius said "Stand aloof from such heretics.. they abstain from the Eucharist & from prayer." (Epistle to the Smyrnaens, ch 7)

VI. The Spread of the Ruling Bishop

A. <u>Clement of Alexandria</u>. Theologian, and taught at school of Alexandria, Egypt. Born c. 150 Athens, Greece Died c. 215 Jerusalem, Israel



"Innumerable such commands have been written in the holy books.. Some to presbyters, some to <u>bishops</u> and <u>deacons</u>.." (Instructor, 3.12; 97.2)

"The grades here in the church, of <u>bishops</u>, presbyters, deacons.." (Miscellanies, 6.13; 106.1-2; 107.2)

"The Ignatian pattern of 1 bishop & a plurality of elders.. spread over the churches & became normal church order by the latter 2nd Century." Ferguson, p171.

VI. The Spread of the *Ruling Bishop*

B. <u>Cyprian</u> of Carthage, born c. 200 AD

He was a prominent trial lawyer & teacher of rhetoric in North Africa.

He was <mark>converted</mark> about 246 AD

And became *bishop* about 248 AD

amidst controversy !! Justus.Anglican.org

"You should know that the bishop is in the church, and the church is <u>in the bishop</u>. If anyone in not <u>with the bishop, he is not in the church</u>."

He meant it for unity. But look at the Result !

VI. The Spread of the *Ruling Bishop*

C. "By the time of <u>Origen</u> in the 3rd century, [185-254 AD] the 3-fold ministry of bishop, presbyters, and deacons was everywhere <u>accepted</u>." Ferguson p. 172.



"All aspects of leadership which belonged to the college of elders soon were exercised by the bishop. Second-century bishops presided at worship (especially the Lord's Supper), administered church funds.. and represented the church in correspondence." Ferguson p.173

2 Tim 2:17 And their talk will spread like gangrene.

VII. Gradual Surrender of Biblical Doctrine

The Apostolic Constitutions

Contains eight treatises on Early Christian discipline, worship, & doctrine, intended to serve as a manual of guidance for the clergy. (Author unknown, written c 390 AD) CONSTITUTIONS THE ORIGINAL CANON LAW OF EARLY ORTHODOX CHRISTIANITY

"<u>We do not permit the rest of the clergy to baptize</u> neither readers, singers, porters, nor ministers. Rather, we permit only the *bishops & presbyters*. *We do not permit presbyters to <u>ordain</u> deacons, deaconesses, readers, ministers, singers.. Rather we permit only the <i>bishops.*" <u>Apostolic Constitutions</u> ANF 7.429

So Philip shouldn't baptize Samaritans? (Acts 8:12)

VIII. Clergy – Laity Distinction Permanent

- The Bible describes the Priesthood of all believers. (1 Pet 2:5) "You also... are being built up for <u>a holy priesthood</u>,
- to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God.
- 1 Pet 2:9 <u>You</u> are a chosen race, <u>a royal priesthood</u>.
- Clergy-People distinction is <u>unknown</u> in 2nd century.
- It's mentioned in the 3rd century. Tertullian: Monogamy, 11f

By 390 AD It's solid "So every person among the <u>laity</u> who does anything without the <u>priest</u> labors in vain." *Clement of Alexandria* ANF 7.420

390 AD "Paul accepts the man who is husband of one wife.. be he presbyter, deacon or <u>layman</u>.." Clement of Alexandria, <u>Miscellanies</u> 3.12; 90.1

IX. The Restoration *Principle*
