- A. Roman Roads: 50,000 miles- Britain to India.
- B. Roman Peace: Pax Romana (27BC AD 180)
- C. Roman Law: Can appeal Caesar (Acts 25:11)
- D. Roman Citizenship: Legal rights (Acts 22:27)
- E. Roman Religion: Bankrupt and corrupt.
- F. Universal Language: Common [Koine] Greek
- G. Roman Domination: left hunger for paradise

- II. RELIGIOUS World in which the Church was born.
 - A. Pharisees: The religious party (John 12:42).
 - 1. John calls them (Mat 3:7) Brood of Vipers
 - 2. Fenced Moses law (Mat 9:11) Eat w/ sinners
 - 3. Note Jesus' Rebuke (Mat 23:2-7, 13-15, 25f)
 - 4. Pharisees believed in (Acts 23:8b)..

 Resurrection, [Man's] Spirit and Angels
 - 5. They were anti-Roman, but Hypocrites!

- II. <u>RELIGIOUS World</u> in which the Church was born.
- B. Sadducees: Priestly, Noble Party (Acts 5:17).
 - 1. They denied (Acts 23:8a) Resurrection,
 Angels, and [man's] Spirit ie surviving death
 - 2. Why irritated at the *preaching*? (Acts 4:1)
 - 3. They were just frankly irreligious [ISBE]
 - 4. HP & sons controlled *Temple Mkt* (Mt 21:13)
 - 5. What was their *plot*? (Mat 26:3-5; 59)

 Note Caiaphas' reasoning (John 11:49-50)

II. RELIGIOUS World in which the Church was born.

C. Essenes: Apocalyptic Party: (says Josephus).

- 1. No animal sacrifice
- 2. Observe the Sabbath
- 3. Communal meals
- 4. Despised marriage
- 5. Expect coming war
- 6. Farmed, Baptized, Moral.
- 7. Avoided cities & Jerusalem
- 8. Avoid War, Wear White.
- 9. Be silent. Bathe in cold H₂O
- 10. Write of Dead Sea Scrolls



II. RELIGIOUS World in which the Church was born.

D. Zealots:

The Nationalistic, Terrorist Party

They thought paying taxes to Caesar was *treason*.



They would try to defeat Rome by any means.

They were one of the reasons Rome attacked Jeru!

Simon the **Zealot** had been one of them (Luke 6:15)

II. RELIGIOUS World in which the Church was born.

E. Sacarii: The Assassins.

Splinter group of the **Zealots**.

(Say some authorities.)

Carried small daggers.

At public gatherings they

attacked Roman soldiers

and Roman sympathizers alike.

Josephus said they massacred 700 men, women and children at En Gedi for not giving them food.

II. RELIGIOUS World in which the Church was born.

F. Herodians: The Political Party—supportive of King Herod's line.

- 1. Involved in *testing* Christ. (Mat 22:36)
- 2. Allied with *Pharisees* to destroy Christ. (Mk 3:6)




- III. ETHNIC World in which the Church was born.
 - (Mat 28:19) "Go.. make disciples of all nations."
 - A. Beginning of the church was all JEWS (Acts 2:5)
 - 1. Peter addressed: Men of Judea (Acts 2:14)
 - 2. He then called them: Israel (Acts 2:22)
 - B. Then Philip went to Samaritans (Acts 8:5-14)
 - 1. They were allied with Judaism religiously
 - 2. But focused on (John 4:20 -21) the mountain
 - C. Now full -blood Gentiles converted (Acts 10:34f)
 - 1. Judiazers mad: Ate w/ sinners. (Acts 11:1-3)
 - 2. God's Gift calmed them down. (Acts 11:17)

IV. Jewish Persecution of Jesus

- A. Jesus p<u>raised</u> as Rabbi & prophet (Mk 6:15; John 9:17)
- B. Jesus <u>criticized</u> as demonic (John 8:48)
 "You have a demon and are a Samaritan."
- C. Jesus condemned as blasphemer (Mat 26:57-67) "He has blasphemed!"
