


Colonies started by people wanting religious freedom, financial opportunity and adventure.


Taxes & More British Taxes

In 1764, England began to impose new laws & taxes. Including: Sugar Act, Currency Act, Quartering Act, and the Stamp Act.

In 1765 Boston protests spread thru the colonies.

In 1773 New tax on Tea-led to Boston "Tea-Party"

In 1774 12 Colonies ask King Geo III to repeal acts.



Elias Smith (1769 – 1846) was a preacher, physician, journalist and clergyman.

1802 Elias Smith left the Baptists & said: "Wear name of *Christian*, without any sectarian name added." Search for Ancient Order p.14


1804 Last Will and Testament of Springfield Presbytery

Wm Guiry (of Virginia) Restoration Preacher.

Herald of Gospel Liberty

Wrote on Dec 18, 1808

First "No <u>head</u> over the church but *Christ*." (Eph 1:22-23)



Second "No confession of faith; Alexander is articles of religion, creeds, 20 and is now or canons but the NT." (1 Pet 4:11) in Glasgow, Scotland

Third "No <u>religious</u> name but Christian." <u>Search of Ancient Order</u> p. 16



1809 Resigned from the **Seceeder Presbyterians.**

1810 Preaches 1st sermon in Bush Run Pennsylvania.

1812 Baptized by immersion



1818 Believes that *baptism is for the remission of sins*, according to Acts 2:38. Search for Ancient Order, p 65.
