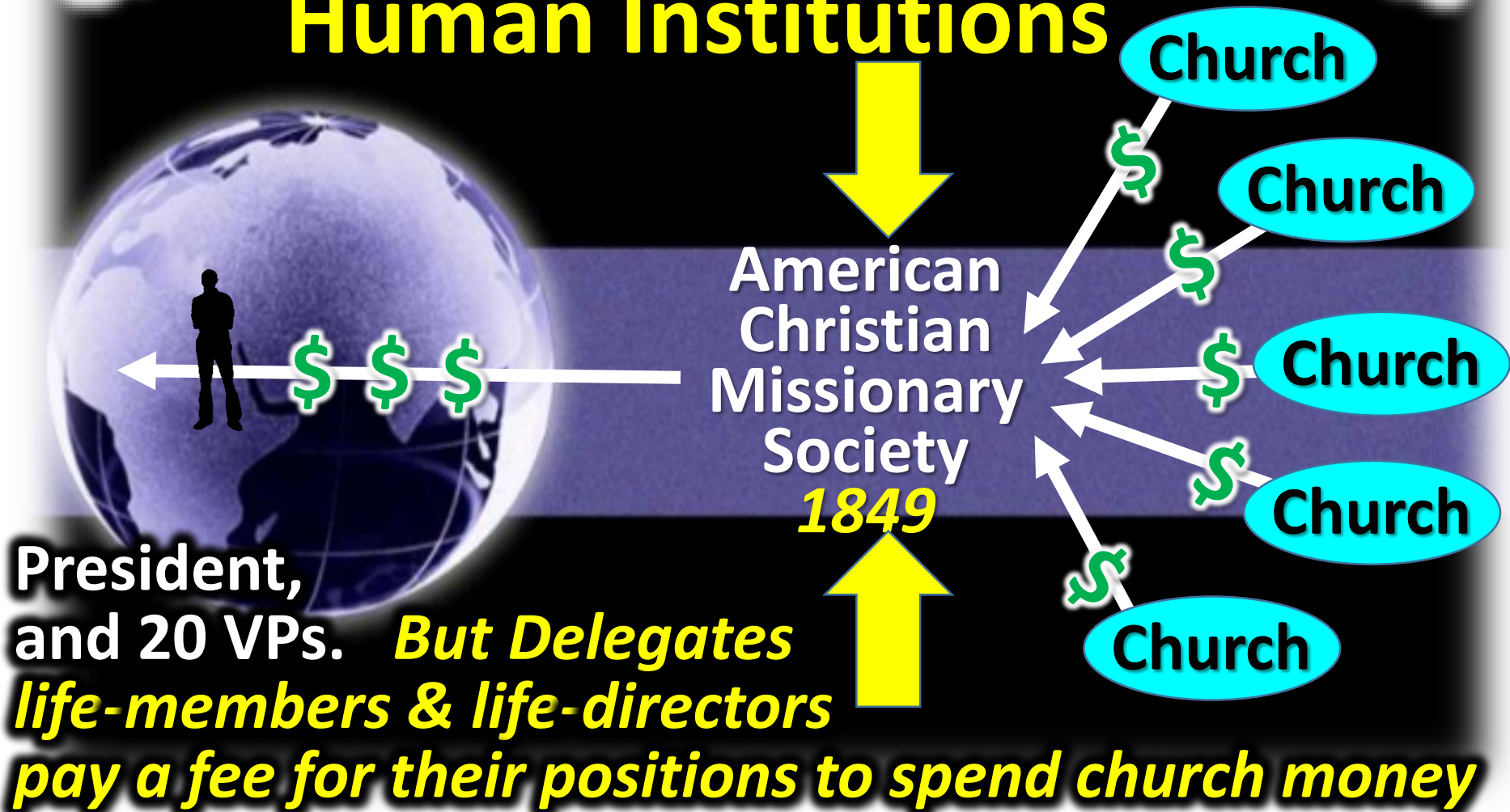

unaccompanied **acapella** singing only.

(Mt 26:30; Acts 16:25; Rom 15:9; Eph 5:19;
Col 3:16; 1 Cor 14:15; Heb 2:12; Jas 5:13)

NT Worship has **NO** scripture authorizing *instrumental music* in the church.



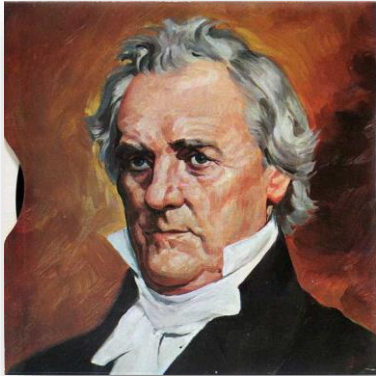
L.L. Pinkerton of the Midway Kentucky was first preacher in the Church of Christ to openly defend instruments in worship, 1860.

Pres. James Buchanan, Dem.

March 4, 1857 – March 4, 1861

Denied the constitutionality of state secession—but also that the nation had no right to force a state to stay!??



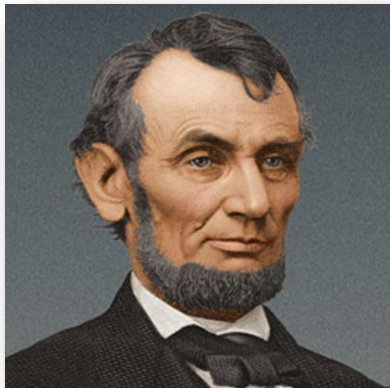
Presidential Election November 1860

A Lincoln, Republican party, 180 votes.

J.C. Breckinridge, Democrat, 72 votes.

S.A Douglas, Southern Dem, 39 votes.

John Bell, Constitution Union, 12 votes.

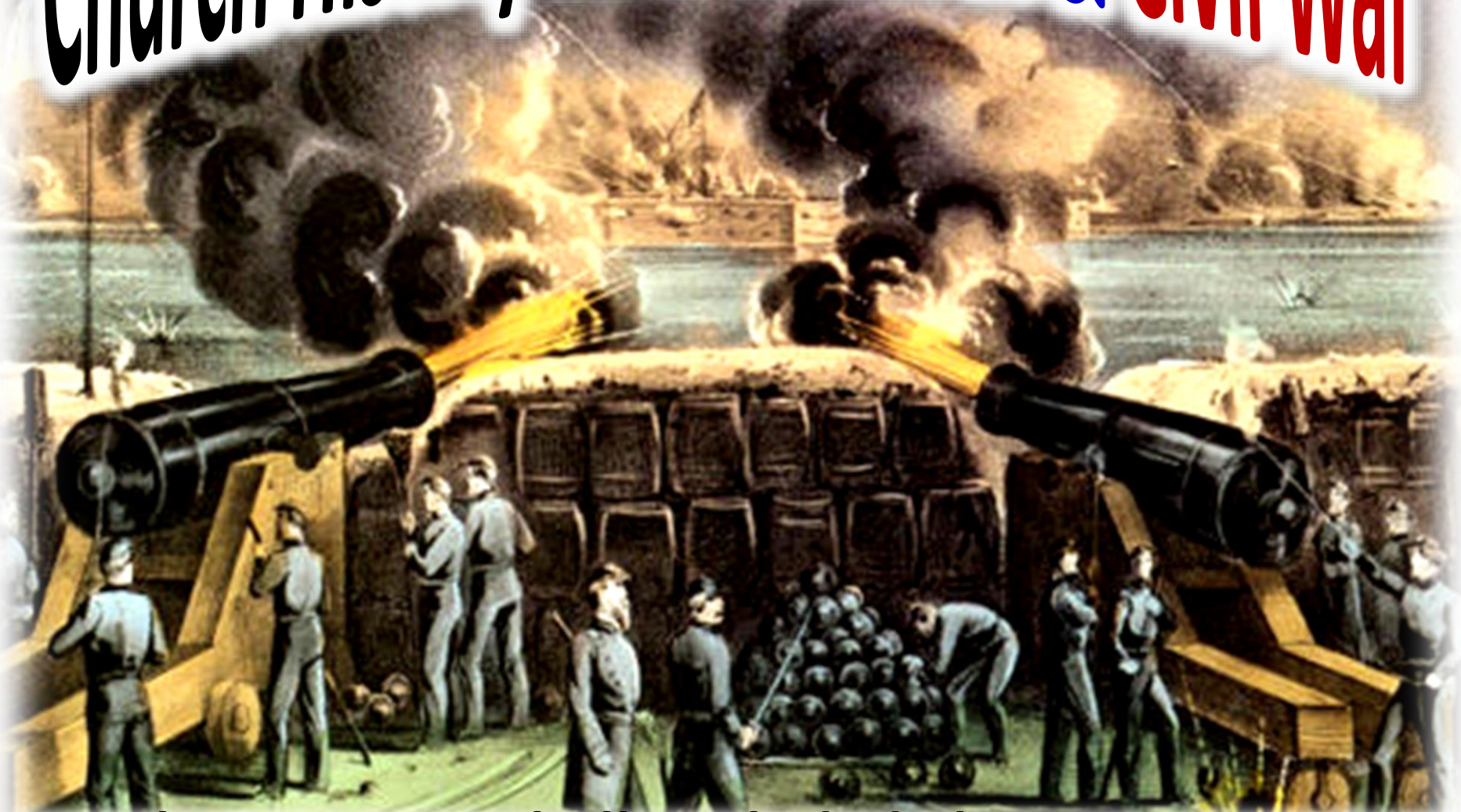


December 20, 1860 S. Carolina seceded followed by several states 6 weeks later. Feb 1861 seceding formed a new gov't, *Confederate States of America*. Jefferson Davis, elected President.
