Rightly Dividing the Word Declaration: We're not introducing anything new. We're not changing anything at all. I've not changed my mind.

We're just developing good study habits.

Rightly Dividing the Word

1. What's wrong in using (Amos 6:4 - 6) in objecting to instrumental music in NT worship?

If (Amos 6) condemns instrumental music it also forbids flopping on sofas v.4; and eating veal or lamb chops too.

Furthermore, instrumental music was commanded in the OT ! (2 Chron 29:25-28) Context in Amos 6 deals with total apathy toward Israel's decline, apostasy and *ruin*. (Amos 6:6°)

Rightly Dividing the Word 2. Are Tattoos forbidden? Lev 19:26 'You shall not make any cuts in your body for the dead, nor make any tattoo marks on yourselves: I am the Lord." NAS What's the weakness in using this argument? 1. It is an OT argument , hence not applicable. 2. And the context shows the prior verse (v.27) prohibits trimming your sideburns or your beard - do you prohibit that? 3. But is everything to God's Glory ? (1 Cor 10:31)

Rightly Dividing the Word 3. What about women wearing *men's clothing*? (Deut 22:5)

1. It is an OT argument, but is there additionally anything behind this principle?

2. USB: "This law deals with transvestism, that is, using clothes normally worn by members of the other sex. It is called an abomination."

3. The reference in (1 Cor 6:9) for effeminate: a male wearing soft things (transvestite) involved in homosexual practices--being condemned.
4. Women's modesty allows slacks. (1 Tim 2:9)
