SLANING GIANIS 1 Samuel 4 17 all.

**Slaying Giants** 1 Sam 14:52 The war against the Philistines was severe all the days of Saul; and when Saul saw any mighty man or any valiant man, he attached **him to his staff.** [On-going, relentless. Like ours!] 1 Sam 17:1 Now the 1 Sam 17:2-3 **Philistines** gathered Saul and the their armies for men of Israel battle ... were gathered.. 1 Sam 17:3-4 Philistines stood on and camped the mountain on one side while in the valley **Israel** stood on the mountain on of Elah the other side..

#### Slaying Giants 1 Sam 17:4 Then a champion came out from the armies of the Philistines named

Goliath, from Gath.

v.4 Height = 9'6" NBA Shaq = 7'1" v.5 Armor: Bronze Helmet, Scale-armor: 157# Barnes.

v.6 bronze greaves on legs. v.7 head of spear 15#.

1) A giant in your life is a person or situation that intimidates you, bullies you & makes you afraid.

#### **Slaying Giants** 1 Sam 17:8 He stood and *shouted to the ranks* of Israel, & said to them, "Why do you come out to draw up in battle array? ... Choose a man for yourselves and let him come down to me.

9 If he is able to fight with me and kill me, then we will become your servants; but if I prevail against him and kill him, you shall become our servants.

10 The Philistine said, "*I defy the ranks of Israel* this day; give me a man that we may fight together."

2) Giants make a lot of noise. We feel dismayed & afraid (v.11). They taunt us morning & night (v.16).

Slaying Giants 1 Sam 17:11 When Saul and all Israel heard these words of the Philistine, they were dismayed and greatly afraid. 1 Sam 16:14 "The Spirit of the Lord departed from Saul, and an evil spirit ... terrorized him." 1 Sam 15:23 "Rebellion is as the sin of divination, and insubordination is as iniquity and idolatry. You have rejected the word of the Lord, He has rejected you from being king." 3) The further you are from God— the bigger your Goliath looks !!!!

In 1 Sam 16:18 David is "A mighty man of valor, a warrior, one prudent in speech, and a handsome man, and the Lord is with him." (likely under age 20)

- v.26 David is NOT impressed with Goliath.
- v.28 Eliab is NOT impressed with bro David.
- v.33 Saul is DOUBTFUL about David.
- v.34-37 David knows his experience & God's Power!

4) Look at your Problem thru the Lord's eyes and it whittles it down to size (Eph 3:20) Exceedingly...

1 Sam 17:37 Saul said to David, "Go, and the Lord be with you."

1 Sam 17:38 "Saul clothed David with his garments & put a bronze helmet on his head, and he clothed him with armor."

v.39 David fastened on his sword over the tunic & tried walking around, because he was not used to them. NIV

5) Don't fight your Giants in another man's armor. Put on your OWN spiritual armor. (Eph 6:10-18)

Tribe of Benjamin was known for an elite corps of slingers (Judg 20:15-16). Seven hundred of them could each "sling a stone at a hair & not miss."

1 Sam 17:40 David.. chose for himself *five smooth stones* from the brook & put them in the shepherd's bag which he had... and his sling was in his hand and he approached the Philistine

1 Sam 17:42-44 Goliath disdained David's youth & threatens him.

1 Sam 17:45 David's challenge:
v.45 I come in Name of Lord
v.46 I will remove your head
v.47<sup>a</sup> Lord doesn't deliver
by sword or spear.
v.47<sup>b</sup> The Battle is the Lord's.
v.48 David ran quickly ... to
meet the Philistine.

6) Are you running away from your Giants— or *Hustling to Take Them Down? (2 Cor 10:4-5)* 

1 Sam 17:49 He took ... a stone and slung it, & *struck the Philistine on his forehead*.. and

The stone sank into his forehead.

#### 1 Sam 17:50 He ... killed him

v.51 Then David ran and stood over the **Philistine and took his** sword and drew it out of its sheath and killed him, & cut off his head with it.

7) Fight from YOUR STRONGEST POINT and then FINISH THE FIGHT !
