Paul's enemies included Jewish-Convert teachers. (2 Cor 10:10 Contemptible; 11:13-15 Deceitful)

Expect both ups & downs — it's Life. (Eccles 7:14)

We all have Allies (Rom 16:3-4)

We all have *Enemies* (Lk 6:26)

v19 For I know that this shall turn out for my deliverance through your prayers and the provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ..
