

Dan 8:1 *In the 3<sup>rd</sup> year* of the reign of Belshazzar the king a vision appeared to me, Daniel, subsequent to the one which appeared to me previously.

**Third year**: this makes the present date **550BC**. (*McQuiggan*). Belshazzar's total reign 553 BC- 539 BC. (NAS Inductive Study Bible)

Subsequent to the one — 2 years after the 4 beasts in chap 8 (Belshazzar's 1st yr)

Dan 4-7 Written in **Aramaic**. Dan 8 -12 All Daniel's visions are grouped together here & written in **Hebrew**.

Dan 8:2 In my vision I saw myself [at] the citadel of Susa in the province of Elam...

#### Apparently chap 7:1 was *dream* as he was asleep and chap 8:1 is a *vision* when he is awake.



Dan 8:2 In my vision I saw myself [in] the citadel of Susa in the province of Elam; in the vision I was beside the Ulai Canal. NIV

<u>Citadel of Susa</u> – Fortress at the Summer capitol of Persia, 200 mi SE. of Babylon.

This bldg is modern.

AMP version: v2 And I saw in the vision & it seemed that I was at Shushan the ..fortress, which is in the province of Elam, & I saw in the vision and I was by the river of Ulai.


The Ulai is cited in an Assyrian inscription by Asshurbanipal (Smith Bible Dict; Asshurbanipal; p 130)

v.3-4 Then I lifted up my gaze and looked and behold, <u>a ram which had two horns</u>.. the horns were long.. but one was longer. I saw the ram butting <u>west.</u>. north and southward..



Historical fact: Persia never advanced toward the east.

#### v.5 A male goat was coming from the west.. without touching the ground. And he had a conspicuous horn between his eyes



### v.6-7 And HE came up to the ram that had two horns .. And rushed at him in his mighty wrath.

#### After several attacks on Greece by Persia... the Greeks were furious. Leupold

Persians are defeated in Asia Minor in 334.

Persians are defeated in Mediterranean Sea in 333

Persians are finally defeated in Babylon in 331

### v.6 <u>And he came up to the ram that had two horns</u> and rushed at him in his mighty wrath and shattered his two horns.

Dan 8:7-8<sup>a</sup> So he hurled him to the ground and trampled on him, and there was none to rescue ... Then the male goat magnified himself exceeding


Alexander was a general at age 16. A governor at age 19, and king at 21. He conquered the world by age 32. Daniel 8 The Two Beasts: Greece & Persia v.8<sup>b</sup> But as soon as he was mighty, the large horn was broken...

He conquered the world then, one year later, he died at age 33, June 11, 323 BC at Babylon.

> Proposed causes are alcoholic liver disease or strychnine poisoning but with little support.

1998 U of Maryland report says Alexander probably died of typhoid fever which, along with malaria, was common in ancient Babylon. 10

v.8<sup>b</sup> But as soon as he was mighty, the large horn was broken; and in its place there came up 4 conspicuous horns toward the four winds of heaven.



### Daniel 8 The Two Beasts: Greece & Persia v.9 Out of one of them came forth a rather small horn which grew exceedingly great toward the south the east.. the beautiful land.

Small horn grew: Antiochus Ephiphanes [God Manifest]

*Reign: 175-164 BC:* Fifth ruler of Syria

**Goal:** Hellenize Kingdom & destroy Jewish culture.

Personality: Powerful, Cruel, Conceited, Extravagant, Tyrannical, Deceitful. "Toward South" Defeated Egypt & gained Palestine.

"Beautiful land" Palestine a land of milk & honey (Ex 20:6)

v. 10 Horn.. grew up to the host of heaven & caused some of the *host of heaven & some of stars to fall to earth & it trampled them down*.

"Host of heaven & stars to fall to earth & trampled" ie Israel & its leaders

(Dan 8:24) He will destroy Mighty men and the holy people.

(Gen 37:9) Joseph saw the "sun, moon & 11 stars" bowing down to him. Jews were slaughtered 170 & 168 BC Daniel 8 The Two Beasts: Greece & Persia v. 11 It even magnified itself to be equal to the commander of the host; & removed the regular sacrifice from Him, & the place of His sanctuary was thrown down. •Forbid Sabbath

"Equal to the commander of the host" God Himself Lord of host used 239 times (Ps 24:10; Isa 1:9; etc)

Program: Destroy all Jewish Resistance !

1 Macc 1:41-63

• Forbid all Feasts • Forbid Sacrifices Forbid Circumcision • Forbid Copies OT • Desecrate the Altar • Mount Idol on Altar • Priests' Chambers demolished Removed gold Gates Burned • Temple Closed 3 yrs

v. 12 <u>On account of Transgression</u> the host will be given over to the horn along with the regular sacrifice, and it will fling truth to the ground, perform its will and prosper.

**Reason:** God didn't lack power! The people were sinning.

Note: Degradation in Malachi (Mal 1:7-8, 10, 13).

v.13-14 How long will the vision about the regular sacrifice apply so as to allow both the holy place & the host to be trampled? And He said to me, "For 2,300 evenings & mornings..."

# *Temple Defiled* = **167**-165 BC. Matthias had 5 zealous sons Judas Maccabeus became leader after father's death Read 1 Macc 2-3 The Maccabean resistance was victorious !

Daniel 8 The Two Beasts: Greece & Persia Dan 8:15 I sought to understand it...16 And I heard the voice of a man between the banks of Ulai, and he called out and said, "Gabriel, give this man an understanding of the vision."

**16 Gabriel** (also occurs in Dan 9:21; Lk 1:19, 26) 17 Time of the end Near the end of Jewish system. 18 **Deep sleep** (Dan 8:27) Exhausted and sick 2 Horns = Kings of Media & Persia 20 Ram = Alexander of Greece & next 4 kings 21 Goat 23 King skilled in intrigue = Antiochus Epiphanes 24 Not by his own power God's providence (Isa 10)
