



Dan 7:1 In the first year of *Belshazzar* king of *Babylon Daniel* saw a dream.

- Nebuchadnezzar Dan 1-4.
- Belshazzar Dan 5.
- Darius Dan 6.





To Babylonian Empire

Reason:

All Daniel's OWN visions are grouped together.

Dan 7:1 "Daniel saw a dream & visions in his mind as he lay on his bed; then he wrote the dream down..."





Dan 7:2 Daniel said, "I was looking in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the great sea.

Wind used 150 times in OT for God's power or controlling influence.

Zech 2:6 Disperse you as the 4 winds..
Ps 104:4 He makes winds His messengers
Jer 49:36 I shall bring on Elam the 4 winds
Rev 7:1-2 Angels holding the back the 4 winds

Dan 7:2 "The four winds of heaven were stirring up the great sea.

The Sea is often used for a metaphor of 'The Nations; or Isa 17:12 Roaring of sea like the rushing of the nations.. society'

Isa 57:20 Tossing sea like the wicked


Rev 17:15 the waters are peoples multitudes, nations, tongues..

Rev 13:1 I saw a beast coming out of the sea..

Rev 21:1 No longer any sea (restless society)

Compare Daniel 2 and Daniel 7





Dan 7:3 "And four great beasts were coming up from the sea, different from one another.

v4 "The first was like *a lion* and had the *wings of an eagle.*"

Nebuchadnezzar likened to a <u>lion</u> Jer 49:19,30; 50:17

Nebuchad.. like an <u>eagle</u> Jer 49: 22, 30; Ezk 17: 3, 12

Winged Lion a Babylonian symbol!

Daniel experienced his deportation **70** years ago!



Dan 7:4 I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and it was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it.

This mighty empire, with the speed of an eagle, and the fierceness of a lion would be checked. Its ferocity would be tamed, and it would be characterized by comparative moderation & humanity.

(Cf Barnes)

Dan 7:5 "And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a bear. And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth beween its teeth; and thus they said to it, Arise, devour much meat!"

Medo-Persians were the next Kingdom to rise to power. (Dan 5:30-31; 6:8; and 8:20)

The bear represents Medo – Persian as generally (not exclusively) a mountain animal.

Bother a bear when eating—that spells trouble!

They were in power 200 years; 539 to 331 BC.

Dan 7:6 "After this I kept looking, and behold, another one, like a leopard, which had on its back four wings of a bird; the beast also had four heads, and dominion was given to it.



Dan 7:7 "After this I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong and it had large iron teeth."

It devoured and crushed, and trampled down the remainder with its feet; & it was different from all the beasts that were before it, & it had 10 horns.

Rome had multiple Caesars & crushed every thing.

Rome conquered Palestine in 63BC under Pompey.

Rome is the iron legs & crumbly feet in Dan 2, a fierce beast here & the abomination of desolation in Dan 9.

Dan 7:8 "While I was contemplating the horns, behold, another horn, a little one, came up among them, and three of the first horns were pulled out by the roots before it..

Emperor Domitian

(McGuiggan; Daniel; p140f)

One of the kings of the 4th beast (v7-8; 24)

A braggart (v8; 20)

Persecutes saints (v21, 25)

Spoke against God (v25)

Claiming himself as Deity. (McGuiggan; p141-143)




Dan 7:9 I kept looking Until thrones were set up, And the Ancient of Days took His seat; His vesture was like white snow, And the hair of His head like pure wool. His throne was ablaze with flames, Its wheels were a burning fire.



God's fiery judgment on throne with WHEELS OF FLAME. (Ezk 1:18, 26-27)

Dan 7:10 "A river of fire was flowing and coming out from before Him; Thousands upon thousands were attending Him, and myriads upon myriads were standing before Him; The court sat, and the books were opened.



Dan 7:10 The court sat, and the books were opened.



Books: God' Word and their evil deeds. (Ex 32:32; Ps 69:28; Ps 139:16; Mal 3:16; Rev. 20:10-12)

Beast was slain: And it's body was destroyed (v.11). National judgment (Rev 19:20-21)

Dan 7:13 " | kept looking in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven one like a Son of Man was coming, and *He came up* to the Ancient of Days And was presented before Him."

This describes

Jesus' Ascension

Acts 1:9; 2:33-34

Not his return to earth!

Dan 7:14 And to him was given dominion, glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations, & men of every language might serve Him.

His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not pass away; and *His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed*.



His kingdom STARTED at his ASCENSION (Rev 1:6)

He has *Dominion* Now! (Eph 1:19-21)

He has Glory Now! (John 17:5)

He has Kingdom Now! (Col 1:13; Lk 1:32-33)
