
The Book of Daniel Chapter Nine Daniel's 70 Prophetic Times

Overview:

v. 1-23 Are Simple v.24-27 Are Difficult 4 cool verses.

Introduction: v.1-3



v.1 In the *first year of Darius* the son of Ahasuerus, of *Median descent*, who was made king over the kingdom of the Chaldeans...

Darius the Mede 538-536BC. Dan 5:1; 6:1 Fausset Contemporaries: Ezra, Nehemiah & Esther. About 3 years away from ending their captivity.

Dan 9:2 In the first year of his reign I, Daniel, observed in the books the number of the years which was revealed as the word of the Lord to Jeremiah the prophet for the completion of the desolations of Jerusalem, namely, 70 years.

v.2 I observed in the books: OT scriptures.

The number of years revealed

to Jeremiah (Jer 25:11-12; 29:10)


Desolations of Jerusalem 70 years:

Daniel is now about.. age 85!

Finally hit Daniel... it's TIME!

What if Tacoma were a ghost town for 70 years?

Dan 9:3 So I gave my attention to the Lord God to seek Him by prayer and supplications, with fasting, sackcloth, and ashes.



By prayer: He's been praying 3 times a day. (Dan 6:10, 13)

<u>Sackcloth</u>: rough material for an emblem of <u>mourning</u>, often worn about the hips. <u>Barnes</u>

Ashes: Worn on the forehead as a sign of distress. UBS

Daniel's Prayer: v.4-19

Confession of **Sins** of the Nation v.4-10

Dan 9:4 "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and lovingkindness.."

God keeps His end of the bargain! (Neh 1:5)

v5 "We have sinned, committed iniquity, acted wickedly, & rebelled, even turning aside from Thy commandments and ordinances."

Neh 1:6 -7 "Confessing the sins of the sons of Israel which we have sinned ... We have acted very corruptly .. not kept commandments.." (Zeph 3:3-4)

Daniel's Prayer: The Curses v.11-14

Dan 9:11 All Israel has transgressed Thy law and turned aside, not obeying Thy voice; so the curse has been poured out on us, along with the oath which is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, for we have sinned against Him.

Dan 9:12 "Thus He has confirmed His words which He had spoken against us ..."

(Deut 28:15, 20 -21, 46 -47)

"Until He has consumed you from this land..."

Daniel's Prayer: Rebuild Jerusalem v.15-19

Dan 9:15 You brought your people out of Egypt. NIV

[You have the Power]

Dan 9:16 Turn away your anger from Jerusalem, your city, your holy hill. אוע

Dan 9:17Look with favor on your desolate sanctuary. NIV

Dan 9:18 We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy... Act! For your sake, O my God (see PS 23:3)

Vision of Gabriel: v.20 -23

Dan 9:21 "While I was still speaking in prayer, then the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision previously..." (Dan 8:15-17; Lk 1:19)

v21 "Time of the evening offering: 3pm (Acts 3:1)

v23 Said: "At the beginning of your supplications.." God began to answer his prayer for Jeru immediately v23 "You are highly esteemed." What do elders think about your goals? What does God & angels think?

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

Dan 9:24 "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city."

a) 70 weeks is cannot be literal.
b) That allows only 1 yr 4 mo.
c) But command to rebuild Jeru (v.25) 3
d) Jerome knew of 9 different interpretations!
e) The answer is contained in 4 verses.

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

Dan 9:24 Have been decreed:

6 Items are fulfilled in *Christ*.

This sets Time fulfilment in the Christian Age.

- #1 To finish Transgression: To restrain, hinder. Kiel (1 Cor 10:13 escape; John 10:29 no one snatch)
- #2 Make an end of sin: To seal up sins. BGD (Jer 31:34 Their sins remembered no more.)
- #3 Make Atonement for inequity: Sacrifice, cover. (Heb 9:26 Put away sin by sacrifice of himself)

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

Dan 9:24 Have been decreed:

6 Items are fulfilled in *Christ*.

- #4 To bring in everlasting righteousness.
 (2 Tim 4:8) Crown of righteousness.. award
- #5 Seal up vision & prophesy. Do away, be extinct, dispose of. (Young, Leupold, Kiel)
 (Luke 24:44) Prophecy is fulfilled in Christ
- #6 Anoint the Most Holy. Pour a substance on body Referring to Messiah (Pulpit, Young, Leupold, Keil) Jesus anointed with Holy Spirit (Acts 10:38; 2:24)

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

Dan 9:24 "Seventy weeks are decreed for your people and your holy city..."

Possibilities:


#1 If literal 70 wks then 1.4 years Daniel to Christ!

- #2 If Day-Year theory (70 wks x 7 days = 490 days)
 - Then switch the days to years = 490 years.
 - Cyrus command to rebuild 536BC (Ezra 1:3)
 - Christian Age didn't begin 46BC (536-490yrs)

#3 If figurative—Seven Prophetic Events, Not years.

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27


Dan 9:25 From the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks



Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

Dan 9:26
"Then after
the sixty-two
weeks the
Messiah will
be cut off .."

Prophecy of Jesus Death Isa 53:8; Mt 1621.



Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

9:26^c People of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.

General Titus & Roman Army of Emperor Vespasian.

70,000 Roman soldiers against 30,000 defenders


Josephus says *a million people were killed* during the siege and 97,000 were captured & enslaved!

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

27^a "And <u>He</u> will make a firm covenant with the many for one week.

CEV wrongly translates this as "This Foreigner"

But the context better fits v26 "The Messiah"



This is Jesus' New Covenant during the Christian Age. Heb 12:24 "Jesus, the mediator of a New Covenant" See also (Heb 2:22 and 8:6) "Better Covenant."

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

v27^b But in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering.

Jesus put a stop to the Old Covenant Sacrifice by the Sacrifice of His own body.



Heb 10:12 He offered one sacrifice for sins for all time.

Answer to Daniel's Prayer: v.24 -27

v27^c and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate."

On the wing— implies speed.

Abominations— Loathed, hated, detestable!

One who makes desolate— Roman Army
(Mat 24:15; Lk 21:20) Jerusalem surrounded by armies, recognize her desolation is at hand.

Poured out on the One who makes desolate—
Romans will fall to barbarians. (Cf Isa 10:12-16)
