




Biblical Pattern: Churches to Saints in Need






Now is Galatians 6 Church Action?

Gal 6:1^a "Even if <u>a man</u> is caught in any trespass, you [Individuals] who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of meekness"


Gal 6:1^b Each one looking to yourself, [Indiv not church] lest you too be tempted.
