


Abraham must have been *Young* sometime. And sometime He took a wife, Sarai (Gen 11:29) And she was beautiful (Gen 12:11)


1. GOD OPENS DOORS

3. THERE'S ALWAYS BATTLES TO FACE




Gen 14:14 When Abram heard that his relative had been taken captive, he led out his trained men, born in his house, 318 men.

He went in pursuit as far as Dan, 140mi from Hebron Eph 6:12 Our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but... against the world forces of this darkness.


4. THERE'S GREAT BLESSINGS TO ENJOY
