4. Assume responsibility for every word you speak.

5. Learn/Continue to speak words that will encourage, comfort...

Col 4:6 Let your speech always be with grace, as though seasoned with salt, so that you will know how you should respond to each person.

In that day, salt was used as a preservative as well as a seasoner.

We must put the salt into our speech to make sure it is pure and properly seasoned
