Walking worthy means: (Col 1:9-14)

Col 1:10 So that you will walk in a manner worthy of the Lord,

Ps 17:5 My steps have held <u>fast to Your paths</u>. My feet have not slipped.

Ps 37:23 The <u>steps of a man are established by the Lord</u>, And He delights in his way.

Ps 119:133 Establish my <u>footsteps in Your word</u>, And do not let any iniquity have dominion over me.

Ps 44:18 Our heart has not turned back, And our steps have not deviated from Your way,

Seeing myself through His eyes!

Eph 5:6 -10 trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord.
